DREAM THEATER COLORADO AWARDED BRONZE

CEDIA EXPO, Denver, September 16, 2006 – Dream Theater Colorado, Northern Colorado’s premier home entertainment company, was awarded the Bronze for Best Technical Design for the level V category Large Home Theater by the Custom Electronic Design and Installation Association (CEDIA). Winners in the various categories were announced at CEDIA’s awards banquet held Saturday night in the Hyatt ballroom across the street from the Colorado Convention Center, where the CEDIA Expo took place. The level V award recognizes achievement and design for home theaters in the \$250,000 to \$399,000 range. Winners were selected by a panel of five experts from the consumer electronics industry jointly with a panel of judges from the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and the American Society of Interior Designers (ASID). As CEDIA boasts members worldwide, the prestigious award places Dream Theater Colorado in very elite company among the best of the best in the world.

The bronze award-winning theater is nearly 6,000 cubic feet, boasts a ten foot screen, three tiers with seating for twelve, and a nearly invisible system installation. A separate room houses the equipment that drives the theater. Components of the installation include THX Ultra II processing and amplification by Lexicon, power management by the colossal Richard Grays Power Company “Powerhouse,” and complete movie managing by the Xperinet MIRV DVD server. A Sonance THX Ultra II 7-channel speaker system was fitted into the room, hidden behind the massive acoustically transparent screen and in the side and rear columns of the room. Bass was accomplished with two powerful subwoofers, each independently equalized to provide the smoothest possible bass response for any seat in the theater. The projection system employed the In Focus 777 three-chip DLP projector and Key Digital’s robust HD Leeza video processor. The elegant room was designed in conjunction with and constructed by ABD of Fort Collins.
